In line with our interest in health, good governance and the nurturing of a forward-looking arts sector, formidAbility is committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment.

- Minimise the printing of paper documents through the use wherever possible of tablet technology for score reading, digital paperwork shared through cloud technology, e-communications with patrons and donors, and predominantly web-based advertising.
- Minimise toxic emissions brought about by our work by encouraging the use of public transport wherever possible though this is sometimes impossible for artists and audience members with physical accessibility requirements.
- Actively promote recycling in rehearsal, meetings and performance, including thoughtful sourcing of sets, props and costumes.
- Actively discourage single-use, non-recyclable plastics in rehearsal and performance spaces, such as non-refillable water bottles.
- Where we can, invest in local economies and community spaces.
